Maypole dancing will be on Saturday 4th May this year. The procession will leave the village hall at 10:00 and dancing on the village green at Church End will commence at about 10:30am

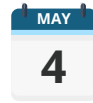

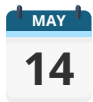
We welcome Martin Holmes back to give a talk on "Harold Wilson" Interesting Times". Harold Wilson was four times election winner for Labour between 1964 and 1976, when he surprisingly resigned. His popularity with the public was not always matched by his own party where many believed he betrayed socialism.

He kept Britain out of the Vietnam war, despite American pressure to join, and held a referendum in 1975 on EEC membership resulting in a resounding success to remain.

Wilson was associated with social liberalisation policies, the 'permissive society', but it is doubtful how much he supported these.

Visitors who may like to find out more about the local u3a and our many special interest groups are welcome to have a taster visit, before joining, at no cost.

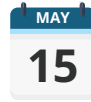
